## Detailed Justification:

Three part request to: expand high volume drive-thru/walk-up testing sites; continue mobile van testing program through Harborview; and expand mobile testing capacity in response to surges.

- 1) Expands high volume drive-through/walk-up testing sites that provide 500-1,000 tests/day in multiple locations in south and east King County. Also partners with Community Health Centers to add medium volume (200-500 tests/day) testing sites to expand testing opportunities for currently underserved communities.
- 2) Continues a mobile van testing program provided by Harborview. Harborview provides these services through two mobile vans and does not have funding to support their Van #2 past the end of September. This request assumes Harborview covers the other half of the operating cost.
- 3) Expand mobile testing capacity to respond immediately when there are outbreaks and surges. Contracts will be developed now to have this capacity ready on demand.
