1	AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
2	approximately 6.47 acres of land into the Covington Water
3	District, known as the Jackson Dean Annexation, for the
4	purpose of water service.
5	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
6	1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of approximately 6.47
7	acres of land into the Covington Water District, known as the Jackson
8	Dean Annexation, for the purpose of providing water service was filed
9	with the county council on September 25, 2020.
10	2. Covington Water District has approved the proposed transfer in
11	Resolution No. 4424, passed on July 14, 2020.
12	3. Covington Water District issued a determination of nonsignificance on
13	the proposed annexation dated June 9, 2020.
14	4. The utilities technical review committee reviewed the Covington Water
15	District comprehensive plan, and found that plan met the criteria for
16	approval. The county approved the most recent plan for the Covington
17	Water District in 2016, as part of Ordinance 18435.
18	5. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has
19	considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.

20	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
21	SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 6.47 acres of land into the
22	Covington Water District for the purpose of providing water service described in
23	Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed
24	annexation is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.
25	SECTION 2. Covington Water District is the appropriate entity to serve
26	the area proposed to be annexed.
27	SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county

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- approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to
- 29 provide service to this annexation area.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION


THAT PORTION OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 22 NORTH, RANGE 6 EAST, W.M., IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, LYING NORTHWESTERLY OF A LINE BEGINNING AT A POINT OPPOSITE HIGHWAY ENGINEER'S STATION (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS HES) EB 1245+00 ON THE EB LINE SURVEY OF SR 18, SR 516 INTERCHANGE TO CEDAR RIVER VICINITY, AND 250 FEET NORTHWESTERLY THEREFROM; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY PARALLEL WITH SAID LINE SURVEY TO A POINT OPPOSITE HES EB 1251+10 THEREON; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE SAID HES EB 1251+10 AND 150 FEET NORTHWESTERLY THEREFROM; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY PARALLEL WITH SAID LINE SURVEY TO A POINT OPPOSITE HES EB 1254+00 THEREON; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE SAID HES EB 1254+00 AND 165 FEET NORTHWESTERLY THEREFROM; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY PARALLEL WITH SAID LINE SURVEY TO A POINT OPPOSITE HES EB 1263+00 THEREON AND THE END OF THIS LINE DESCRIPTION.

EXCEPT THAT PORTION LYING NORTHEASTERLY AND NORTHERLY OF A LINE DESCRIBED AS; BEGINNING AT A POINT OPPOSITE HES EB 1260 ON SAID LINE SURVEY AND 165 FEET NORTHWESTERLY THEREFROM; THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY PARALLEL WITH SAID LINE SURVEY TO HES EB 1258+30; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE SAID HES EB 1258+30 AND 182.35 FEET NORTHWESTERLY THEREFROM; THENCE WESTERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE HES 200TH 20+00 ON THE 200TH LINE SURVEY OF SAID HIGHWAY, AND 30 FEET SOUTHERLY THEREFROM; THENCE NORTHERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE SAID HES 200TH 20+00 AND 30 FEET NORTHERLY THEREFROM AND THE END OF THIS LINE DESCRIPTION.

THE GRANTEE HEREIN, ITS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS, SHALL HAVE NO RIGHT OF INGRESS AND EGRESS TO, FROM AND BETWEEN SAID SR 18 AND THE LANDS HEREIN CONVEYED; NOR SHALL THE GRANTEE HEREIN, ITS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS, BE ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION FOR THE LOSS OF LIGHT, VIEW AND AIR OCCASIONED BY THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, OR OPERATION OF SAID HIGHWAY.

THE SPECIFIC DETAILS CONCERNING ALL OF WHICH ARE TO BE FOUND ON SHEETS 8 AND 9 OF THAT CERTAIN PLAN ENTITLED SR 18, SR 516 INTERCHANGE TO CEDAR RIVER VICINITY, NOW OF RECORD AND ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION AT OLYMPIA, AND BEARING DATE OF APPROVAL AUGUST 4, 1995, AS REVISED.
