Ordinance 19211

Proposed No. 2020-0312.2 **Sponsors** Kohl-Welles AN ORDINANCE relating to county property tax levies for 1 collection in 2021; implementing RCW 84.55.0101, finding 2 substantial need and providing for a limit factor of one 3 hundred and one percent in accordance with RCW 4 84.55.0101. 5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 6 7 SECTION 1. Findings: A. RCW 84.55.0101 allows the county council to set limit factors for regular 8 property tax levies to a maximum of one hundred one percent upon a finding of 9 10 substantial need. B. The total adopted King County budget for 2021-2022 is \$12.59 billion and the 11 total adopted general fund budget for 2021-2022 is \$1.92 billion. 12 C. The general fund and other funds are experiencing a fiscal shortfall that is the 13 result of revenue growth that is not keeping pace with the increasing costs of providing 14 services. 15 D. This fiscal shortfall is expected to continue in 2021 and thereafter. 16 E. King County has aggressively reviewed all expenditures in the General Fund 17 18 and other property-tax-supported funds for reductions and has reviewed possibilities for enhanced revenues. 19

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F. King County has reduced the general fund budget and other property-taxsupported budgets below the amounts necessary to sustain current service levels through direct service reductions and efficiencies. G. The 2021-2022 budget assumes that property taxes increase by the onepercent limit factor and any increase less than that would require substantial direct service reductions. H. Because of the findings in subsections A. through G. of this section, the King County council finds that a substantial need exists for the use of property tax limit factors up to the maximum of one hundred one percent. SECTION 2. The limit factors to be used for county property tax levies for taxes to be collected in 2021 shall be as follows: Limit Factor Levy Regular Levy One hundred one percent One hundred one percent Emergency Medical Services (EMS) County Road District One hundred one percent **Conservation Futures** One hundred one percent
