1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2020 levy of property  
 2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2021; and  
 3 amending Ordinance 19215, Section 1, Ordinance 19215,  
 4 Section 2, Ordinance 19215, Section 3, and Ordinance  
 5 19215, Section 4.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 19215, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 The county assessor of King County has certified to the metropolitan King  
 9 County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized  
 10 amounts to \$((656,203,218,952)) 656,422,379,001.

11 SECTION 2. Ordinance 19215, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 The metropolitan King County council imposes the levies necessary to fund  
 13 estimated expenditures for the year 2021 as listed in this section. These amounts do not  
 14 include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including  
 15 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In  
 16 accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes  
 17 available to the county related to new construction, improvements to property, refunds  
 18 and any increase in the assessed value of state assessed property. In calculating the  
 19 amount of regular property tax moneys needed, the council was cognizant of these sums

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20 and they are therefore included in the following levy totals.


