	Proposed No. 2010-0193.2 Sponsors Patterson and Drago
1	AN ORDINANCE pertaining to the roads capital
2	improvement program; and amending the 2010/2011
3	Biennium Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 16717, Section
4	137, as amended, and Attachment G, as amended; and
5	declaring an emergency.
6	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
7	SECTION 1. Findings:
8	A. The South Park Bridge, built in 1931, is at the end of its useful life. Its
9	concrete support structure is undergoing a self-destructive process that cannot be reversed
10	or repaired. The heavily cracked piers are unstable and shift on their foundations. The
11	concrete itself is actually crumbling in many places due to contamination in the concrete
12	when the bridge was built.
13	B. The piers have tilted toward the middle of the river so much that, even after
14	many modifications, the bridge cannot be properly closed and the moveable parts fully
15	seated. The mechanical and electrical systems that open and close the bridge to let
16	vessels through are unreliable.
17	C. Even after shoring and repairs were completed following the 2001 Nisqually
18	earthquake, the bridge is seven times more vulnerable to earthquake damage than the
19	Alaskan Way Viaduct.

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20	D. There are frequent problems that prevent the bridge from operating properly,
21	causing significant delays for both vehicular and boat traffic.
22	E. The problems with the bridge structure are so extensive that there are no
23	feasible repair options. The significant extent and nature of these structural problems,
24	coupled with the poor initial construction of the bridge, mean the bridge must be
25	scheduled to close on June 30, 2010, for the public's safety.
26	F. Planning for closure of the South Park Bridge requires an extensive process of
27	consulting with affected citizens, local governments, fire and police departments, school
28	districts, and transportation agencies.
29	G. With the June 30 closure date less than eleven weeks away, appropriation
30	authority for right-of-way acquisition is needed without delay so the closure preparations
31	can proceed as planned.
32	SECTION 2. Ordinance 16717, Section 137, as amended, is hereby amended by
33	adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
34	ROADS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM - The executive is hereby
35	authorized to execute any utility easements, bill of sale or related documents necessary
36	for the provision of utility services to the capital projects described in Attachment G to
37	this ordinance, but only if the documents are reviewed and approved by the custodial
38	agency, the real estate services division, and the prosecuting attorney's office. Consistent
39	with the requirements of the Growth Management Act, Attachment G to this ordinance
40	was reviewed and evaluated according to King County Comprehensive Plan. Any project
41	slated for bond funding will be reimbursed by bond proceeds if the project incurs
42	expenditures before the bonds are sold.

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43	The two primary prioritization processes that pro	ovided input to the 2010 - 2015
44	Roads Capital Improvement Program are the Bridge Pri-	ority Process published in the
45	Annual Bridge Report, and the Transportation Needs Re	eport.
46	From the roads services capital improvement fur	nds there are hereby appropriated
47	and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for	or the specific projects identified

65	P2 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:	

66	For CIP Project 300197, South Park Bridge Replacement, ((no more than
67	\$761,000)) none of the amount appropriated in 2010 may be expended or encumbered
68	until the executive has transmitted, and the council has approved by motion, a funding
69	plan for the project. Any ordinance necessary for implementation of the funding plan
70	shall be transmitted with the plan.
71	Any plan or legislation required to be submitted by this proviso must be filed in
72	the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk of the council, who
73	shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers and to the
74	committee coordinator for the physical environment committee or its successor.
75	SECTION 3. Attachment A to this ordinance hereby amends Attachment G to
76	Ordinance 16717, as amended, by adding thereto and inserting therein the projects listed
77	in Attachment A to this ordinance.
78	SECTION 4. For the reasons listed in Section 1 of this ordinance, the county

79 council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is

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80 necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the

81 support of county government and its existing public institutions.
