held a public hearing remately to comply with motely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-29 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 beginning at 1:00 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0413 (Ordinance 19146) an ordinance adopting 2020 amendments to the 2016 King County Comprehensive Plan (Comprehensive Plan), and as amended in 2017 and 2018, including the proposed adoption of the Skyway-West Hill Land Use Strategy as an amendment to, and element of, the Comprehensive Plan. The Council then adopted this Ordinance at the Friday, July 24, 2020 meeting.

SUMMARY:

The Comprehensive Plan is the guiding policy document for all land use and development regulations in unincorporated King County, and for such countywide regional services as transit, solid waste, wastewater treatment, parks, trails, and open space. The Comprehensive Plan is required by the state Growth Management Act. Proposed updates to the King County Comprehensive Plan were transmitted by the King County Executive

on September 30, 2019. Briefings were held in the Mobility and Environment Committee between October 2019 and February 2020. Council action took place on July 24, 2020.
