1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2021-0179, VERSION 2**

2 On page 10, beginning on line 216, strike lines 216 through 219, and insert:

3 "SECTION 11. Ordinance 19210, Section 20, as amended, is hereby amended as  
4 follows:

5 SHERIFF - From the general fund there is hereby appropriated to:

6 Sheriff \$2,295,000"

7  
8 On page 12, after line 268, insert:

9 "ER8 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

10 Of this appropriation, \$200,000 shall be expended or encumbered solely to  
11 support a wellness and resiliency pilot project in the sheriff's office. To improve on-the-  
12 job performance and reduce the use-of-force instances and community complaints, the  
13 wellness and resiliency program shall facilitate and provide for department of public  
14 safety employees access to health and wellness resources, such as programs to combat  
15 dependency on alcohol or drugs and mental and physical health improvement programs,  
16 as well as to provide voluntary debriefs among and with deputies and detectives engaged  
17 in high-stress work such as a rotation in the child pornography investigation unit. The

18 program may not administer county benefits but, rather, will address the unique stressors  
19 in law enforcement and connect department of public safety employees to resources."

21 On page 14, after on line 307, insert:

22 "P3 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

23 Of this appropriation, \$10,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the  
24 sheriff's office transmits a health and wellness program report and a motion that should  
25 acknowledge receipt of the report is passed by the council. The motion should reference  
26 the subject matter, the proviso's ordinance number, ordinance section, and proviso  
27 number in both the title and body of the motion.

28 The report shall include, but not be limited to:

29 A. A description of the health and wellness programs facilitated by the wellness  
30 and resiliency program and offered to department of public safety personnel, including  
31 those programs intended to assist in coping with stress, combatting substance dependency  
32 of alcohol and drugs and improvements to mental and physical health;

33 B. An assessment of the program's contribution to increasing individuals'  
34 willingness to seek help;

35 C. An assessment of the participation rates of sworn sheriff officers and civilian  
36 employees in the department of public safety in each health and wellness program  
37 facilitated by the wellness and resiliency program; and

38 D. An evaluation of the effectiveness of the health and wellness programs  
39 facilitated by the wellness and resiliency program.

40 The sheriff's office should electronically file the report and motion required by

41 this proviso no later than September 30, 2022, with the clerk of the council, who shall  
42 retain an electronic copy and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the  
43 council chief of staff and the lead staff for the law and justice committee, or its  
44 successor."

46 **EFFECT prepared by B. Vena: This amendment would add \$200,000 in General**  
47 **Fund moneys to KCSO and expenditure restrict that same amount for work done by a**  
48 **wellness and resiliency program and would add \$10,000 in General Fund moneys to**  
49 **KCSO and proviso that same amount for a report on the health and wellness programs**  
50 **facilitated by wellness and resiliency program and offered to sheriff's office**  
51 **personnel.**

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
