**Proposed No.** 2021-0231.2 **Sponsors** Dembowski and von Reichbauer 1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans to nonprofit organizations and local governments to meet 2 the needs of low-income, seniors or young people or people 3 4 with disabilities. WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its residents to increase 5 6 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation, 7 and WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to nonprofit organizations and local 8 governments serving individuals with limited resources and mobility options can support 9 10 those goals and provide significant public benefits, and WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining value and utility are 11 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and 12 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred 13 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, seniors, disabled and young people, and 14 15 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.56.100 states that each year, "the Metro transit department shall make available retired passenger vans for exclusive use by nonprofit organizations 16 or local governments that are able to address the mobility needs of low-income, seniors 17 or young people or people with disabilities," and 18 WHEREAS, in recognition of the operational, health and safety changes 19

20 organizations have made in response to the coronavirus disease 2019 emergency, Ordinance 19241 provides that, "for the duration of the public emergency declared by the 21 22 executive in response to the coronavirus disease 2019, the specific plans may also include 23 use of the van to transport goods or supplies, including, but not limited to, food, clothing, school supplies or medical equipment, to serve the needs of low-income, seniors or 24 young people or people with disabilities"; 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The 26 transfer of a retired vanpool passenger van to each of the following agencies is hereby 27 28 approved: 29 AmPowering; Billie Pearl; 30 Boys & Girls Clubs of King County's Federal Way Boys & Girls Club; 31 Cham Refugees Community; 32 33 City of Auburn Senior Center; 34 City of Pacific Senior Center; Comunidad Latina de Vashon; 35 36 Communities in Schools; Community Homes; 37 Community Leaders Roundtable of Seattle; 38 39 Congolese Integration Network; Cultures United FC; 40 Duwamish Tribal Services; 41 42 Duwamish Valley Youth Corps;
