The public hearing is planned to either be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Room 1001, Scattle, Washington; or the hearing may be required to be held remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-29 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act.
