Today, I write urging the Mobility and Environment committee to approve proposed Ordinance No. 2021-0200: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to sign the recreational trail use agreement with Puget Sound Energy for permission to use portions of PSE property for the construction, maintenance, and operation of the Interurban Trail South.

Approving this agreement will pave the way for King County to use Parks Levy dollars to make important safety improvements to this heavily used trail so individuals from historically underserved communities can enjoy a non-motorized transportation option connecting them economic opportunities.
