The Board received an update on the work Sound Transit is doing to update its transit oriented development policy. The Board was also brought up to date on the work that is being done with the City of Bellevue regarding cost saving revenues on the east link design.

Mr. McDermott briefed the Council on the recent Board of Health meeting, indicating it was the last meeting of the year. The Board discussed King County's budget and its affect on public health activities and services. There will be no drastic cuts to public health services this year. The members discussed the need for a sustainable funding source for public health from the state.
