AN ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of one or more series of limited tax general obligation bonds of the county in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$100,000,000 to refinance for savings the county's obligations under the lease/lease-back transaction entered into by the county with Goat Hill Properties for the permitting, design, construction and equipping of a county office building now known as the Chinook Building and the related parking facility now known as the Goat Hill Parking Garage; providing for the use of the bond proceeds to refund all or a portion of the lease revenue bonds issued by Goat Hill Properties and to pay costs of issuing the county's bonds; and pledging the annual levy of taxes to pay principal of and interest on the county's bonds.
