Advertised Public Hearing to Comply with the Requirements of the Growth Management Act

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Ordinance 18269 enacted a four-month moratorium commencing on April 25, 2016 that prohibits the acceptance of applications for or the establishment or location of marijuana producers, marijuana processors and marijuana retailers. Ordinance 18269 was adopted by the Council on April 25, 2016. The public hearing is being held as required by the Growth Management Act, chapter 36.70A RCW.
