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9. Proposed Ordinance No. 2020-0110

AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on August 4, 2020, of a proposition authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW for a consecutive six-year period, at a total rate of not more than \$2.25 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation in the first year for collection in 2021 and limiting annual levy increases by the King County inflation plus population index published by the King County office of economic and financial analysis, or the limitation in chapter 84.55 RCW, whichever is greater in years two through six, and authorizing use of the 2026 levy amount as the base for computing levies in succeeding years, for the purpose of maintaining and operating King County's road system.
