Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:34 p.m.

Ms. Patterson led the flag salute and Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Approval of Minutes of October 16, 2006

Mr. Gossett moved to approve the minutes of the October 16, 2006 meeting as presented. Seeing no objection, the Chair so ordered.

2. <u>Reports on Special and Outside Committees</u>

Ms. Patterson reported on the South County Area Transportation Board meeting held at SeaTac. The Board discussed a letter that will be presented to the Regional Transportation Investment District. The letter will provide input from South County's perspective.

Ms. Patterson reported on the Board of Health. The Board had a briefing from State Representative Shay Schual-Berke regarding recommendations of the Public Health Finance Committee. The purpose of the committee is to find a way to secure stable funding for public health. The Board received an update regarding the Overweight Prevention Initiative. Ms. Patterson also noted that the Board passed a resolution which was sponsored by Ms. Lambert and Ms. Patterson which encourages health care professionals to screen all patients for domestic violence. Ms. Lambert made comments, noting Mr. Phillip's attendance at the meeting. She also commented on the statistics showing the number of men who are victims of domestic violence.

Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the Public Health Operational Master Plan Steering Committee. The Committee reviewed the comments that were the result of a stakeholder's survey, requesting opinion on the operational master plan policy framework. The Committee also had a briefing on Phase II of the operational master plan.

Ms. Lambert also made comments, thanking Ms. Patterson for her leadership.

Mr. Constantine reported on his attendance at the 2006 Regional Leadership Conference. The topic was work force development.
