He indicated that a number of issues that affect us both regionally and with the involvement of the federal government were discussed. He complimented the Ferguson Group in their organization and interest in representing King County.

*Mr.* Phillips also commented on meeting with our United States Senators and the House delegation. He stated that our delegation was welcomed and had a chance to move forward with our adopted 2007 legislative program.

*Mr.* von Reichbauer added special thanks to *Mr.* Gossett for his leadership with this delegation, and great job in leading the discussions. He also stated that the upcoming External Affairs Committee meeting of March 6 will be in Olympia in the Capitol Building, and will conclude with a luncheon. Every member, and every representative and senator representing King County is invited. *Mr.* Dunn also spoke of the delegation to Washington, D.C., lobbying for critical needs. He commented on additional Army Corps of Engineers funding.
