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Mr. Phillips reported on Sound Transit Central Link construction, indicating the initial segment is ninety percent complete. He gave an update on construction of several other segments. Mr. Phillips reported the members had a good update, and that light rail will be complete for opening on time in July, 2009.

Mr. Gossett briefed the Council on the Growth Management Planning Council, indicating the Council has been working hard on annexations of urban unincorporated communities. Mr. Gossett indicated a proposal was before the Council concerning Burien and the City of Seattle regarding annexing all or part of the Highline area.

Mr. Constantine reported on the Prosperity Partnership trip to southwest Washington and Vancouver. The Prosperity Partnership's focus is economic development between Puget Sound's economy and other regions of our state.

Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the recent Board of Health meeting. She indicated the Board adopted sewage and on site septic system regulations, which will reform the County's health code. The Board received briefings on nutrition in public schools. Ms. Patterson indicated that the next meeting will be devoted to the topic King County's budget.
