AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on September 19, 2006, of a proposition authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, at a rate of not more than \$0.0525 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation for collection in 2007, and limited each year thereafter by chapter 84.55 RCW, for the purpose of funding the continued operation of the automated fingerprint identification system.
