BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (Court Reporters - Superior Court) representing employees in

the King County superior court, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.
