AN ORDINANCE relating to animal and pet fees; making technical corrections; and amending Ordinance 7416, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 11.04.035 and prescribing penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes to the license fees and penalty charges by the county animal control authority.

B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7416, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 11.04.035 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

License fees and penalties.
