



WHEREAS, in Ordinance 17476, passed on November 13, 2012, the council requested that the executive transmit by April 1, 2013, a report that identifies how the ADAP addresses the following:

1. The compiled annual number of requests for stream and drainage ditch cleaning for 2008-2012;
2. The average duration of time between request for stream and drainage ditch cleaning and completion of the work for 2008-2012;
3. The actions that the county is taking to assist those requesting assistance with cleaning and drainage ditch cleaning;
4. The estimated acreage of agricultural lands that is not farmable because of poor drainage;
5. A plan for how the county can facilitate or assist in locating, repairing or replacing drainage tiles; and
6. A detailing of any regulatory impediments to more quickly providing stream cleaning and repair or replacement of drainage tiles, and

WHEREAS, the executive has transmitted a report that addresses each of these elements;
