A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with Albertson's, to provide a police substation facility in the Renton area.

WHEREAS, Albertson's voluntarily, without coercion or inducement, wishes to provide a police substation facility to enhance law enforcement community outreach services, and

WHEREAS, the sheriff's office has a high commitment toward community based policing, and

WHEREAS, a police substation facility will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve in the public's interest and provide a higher degree of community based policing, and

WHEREAS, this interlocal agreement is intended neither to influence a particular county action nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by King County sheriff's deputies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form attached to this motion, with Albertson's to provide a police substation facility.
