BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the July 19, 2001 report and recommendation of the hearing examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on January 16, 2002, upon the application of Atcon Construction Co., Inc. to reclassify certain property described in development and environmental services file no. L00TY405.
