SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated between King County and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 117 representing employees in the prosecuting attorney's office and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2008, through and including December 31, 2010.
