AN ORDINANCE relating to the change of name of King County fire protection district no. 39 and King County fire protection district no. 26, which were merged by the voters, to "South King Fire and Rescue."

### STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. On September 20, 2005, the voters approved the merger of the Federal Way fire department, King County fire protection district no. 39, and the Des Moines fire department, King County fire protection district no. 26.
2. The boards of commissioners of both King County fire protection district no. 39 and King County fire protection district no. 26 have determined that it would be in the best interest of the district to change the name of the merged fire districts to "South King Fire and Rescue."

3. Fire protection district no. 39 adopted Resolution No. 395 and fire protection district no. 26 adopted Resolution No. 1164-05-05 on May 25, 2005, which was filed with the King County council on October 12, 2005, resolving to change the name of the merged "South King Fire and Rescue."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County council, under RCW 52.30.060, approves the change in the name of merged King County fire protection district no. 39 and King

County fire protection district no. 26 to "South King Fire and Rescue."
