AN ORDINANCE relating to the development of an equestrian trail through

Marymoor park to connect with the Bridle Crest and Sammamish trails; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

SECTION 1. Ordinance 15652, Section 82, as amended, is hereby amended to delete the following:

PARKS AND RECREATION - From the parks 2004 levy fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Parks and recreation \$23,084,309

The maximum number of FTEs for parks and recreation shall be: 155.98

((P1 PROVIDED THAT:

Of this appropriation, \$250,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the executive submits to the council a report identifying potential routes for the development of an equestrian trail through Marymoor park to connect with the Bridle Crest and Sammamish trails. The report shall include a cost estimate and identify an appropriate funding source.
