AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, prohibiting parking during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., school days only; amending Ordinance 5292, Schedule 16, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the department of transportation, road services division, traffic engineering studies and as authorized by chapter 46.90 RCW, Ordinance 5292, Section 16, as amended, which prohibits parking from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. - school days only, along county roads, is amended to add the following roadways:

A. 91st Avenue Northeast, 225 feet south of Northeast 176th Street to 92nd Avenue Northeast, east and west sides.

B. 92nd Avenue Northeast, from Northeast 175th Street to Northeast 178th Street, east and west sides.

C. Northeast 175th Street, on the north side between 92nd Avenue Northeast, to a point 250 feet east of 92nd Avenue Northeast.

D. Northeast 175th Street, on the south side between 92nd Avenue Northeast and 93rd Avenue Northeast.

SECTION 2. Signs posted to evidence the restriction described in section 1 of this ordinance shall be installed by the proper authority.
