WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general elections held in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 14758 provides for submission to the voters on November 4, 2003, of a

proposed amendment to Article 4 of the King County Charter to provide for biennial budgeting;
