



WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 39.04.280 and K.C.C. 2.93.080, the King County executive on June 26, 2018, issued an Executive Determination of Emergency declaring that immediate steps needed to be taken to complete the repair work by September 30, 2018, and transmitted notice to the council on the same day, and

WHEREAS, the executive, through the Executive Determination of Emergency, waived competitive procurement requirements in accordance with RCW 39.04.010 and K.C.C. 4A.100.070 and K.C.C. chapters 2.93, 12.16 and 12.18, and

WHEREAS, due to project conditions and schedules, the road services division of the King County department of transportation completed the repair work on September 28, 2018, at a cost of \$697,380, and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.235(12) authorizes King County to use public employees without limitation for emergency work performed under an emergency declared pursuant to RCW 36.32.270. The statute requires the council to pass a motion certifying the damage to public facilities and costs related to correcting the emergency within fourteen days of the finding of emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The council certifies the damage to the Stossel Right Bank Revetment.
- B. The council certifies the costs incurred for the road services division of the King County department of transportation forces to repair the revetment were \$697,380.
