WHEREAS, King County is dependent on a strong fiscal partnership with the federal government for transportation, public health, homeland security, salmon recovery, flood control, affordable housing and other important needs, and

congressional developments for possible revisions of King County's 2012 (FY 2013) federal legislative goals;
