BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>NEW SECTION. SECTION 1.</u> There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 12.68 a new section to read as follows:

The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no shooting area is established within the Merganser voting precinct and is described as follows:

The area is in all that portion of Section 15, Township 21 north, Range 6 east, W.M. lying westerly of
