WHEREAS, in Ordinances 14711 and 15157, the metropolitan King County council established citizens' election oversight committees to review the conduct of elections in King County, to identify problems and to make recommendations, and

WHEREAS, those committees have consistently provided invaluable service to county voters and county government, and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453 the council established a new citizens' elections oversight committee

and adopted criteria for membership on the committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The appointment of Timothy Borders to the King County citizens' election oversight committee, as a representative of the registered voters of King County who are not representatives of any of the groups who are represented on the committee, for a term to expire on January 29, 2008, is hereby confirmed.
