BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Redmond's application and negotiated agreement meets the criteria for a right -of-way franchise for use of the right-of-way of County roads for the construction and maintenance of water and sewer facilities under K.C.C. 6.27.

SECTION 2. The executive is authorized to execute a right-of-way franchise agreement with the City of Redmond that is substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, and to take all actions necessary to implement the terms of the franchise agreement.
