AN ORDINANCE authorizing the executive to enter into an interlocal agreement between King County and the city of Enumclaw regarding the operation of the Enumclaw pool.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. King County (county) and the city of Enumclaw (city) have agreed to terms for an interlocal agreement for the operation of the Enumclaw pool.
2. The recitals in the agreement set forth relevant facts supporting and explaining the terms of the transfer.
3. King County and the city have agreed that the county will operate the Enumclaw pool for the period of January 1, 2003 to March 31, 2003.

4. Continued operation of the Enumclaw pool under the terms and conditions of the attached agreement will serve an important county purpose by ensuring that the pool will remain open and available to all county residents.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form of the attached agreement, with the city of Enumclaw relating to the operation of the Enumclaw pool.
