BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated between King County and Washington State Nurses Association (Supervisors and Managers) representing employees in the Seattle-King County department of public health and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part

hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2005, through and including December 31, 2007.
