BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memorandum of understanding negotiated between King County and the Animal Control Officers Guild, representing employees in the department of executive services, and attached to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2003, through and including December 31, 2003.
