AN ORDINANCE establishing a new fund for the department of public health;

and adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 4A.200.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 4A.200 a new section to read

### as follows:

- A. There is hereby created the public health administration fund.
- B. The fund shall be a second tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.
- C. The director of the department of public health shall be the manager of the fund.

- D. The fund shall account for administrative, leadership and overhead cost for the department of public health.
- E. The fund shall be used to support the department administrative and leadership activities. The revenue in this fund shall be collected from other funds in the department of public health.
