



county executive staff evaluated the proposals, conducted interviews and unanimously determined that the proposal from Jones Lang LaSalle best meets the selection criteria outlined in the RFP, and

WHEREAS, the county auditor also evaluated the consultants' proposals and references, determined that Jones Lang LaSalle has the qualifications and expertise to conduct this oversight project and recommends council approval of Jones Lang LaSalle, and

WHEREAS, Motion 10651, Section III, as amended, and OR 1-020 requires the council to authorize the council chair to sign any contracts in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars in the legislative branch;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The chair of the metropolitan King County council is authorized to enter into a contract, in an amount not to exceed thirty thousand dollars with Jones Lang LaSalle to provide oversight of the design and construction of the Ninth and Jefferson Building.
