1. King County and the city of Redmond (city) have agreed to terms for an interlocal agreement for the transfer of Bridle Crest Trail.

2. The recitals in the agreement set forth relevant facts supporting and explaining the terms of the transfer.

3. King County and the city have agreed that the transfer will take place within thirty days

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement,

substantially in the form of the attached agreement, with the city of Redmond relating to the transfer of Bridle

Crest Trail.
