AN ORDINANCE increasing the filing fee for mandatory arbitration cases in

superior court under RCW 36.18.016; and amending Ordinance 13842, Section 2,

and K.C.C. 4.71.115.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance increases the fee for filing a request for mandatory

arbitration.

B. This increase is authorized under RCW 36.18.016, as amended by the 2002 state legislature, which

allows counties to impose a fee for filing a request for mandatory arbitration.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 13842, Section 2, and K.C.C. 4.71.115 are each hereby amended to read as

follows:

Filing fee - mandatory arbitration request. The department of judicial administration is hereby authorized to assess and collect a fee for filing a request for mandatory arbitration, as authorized in RCW 36.18.016. The fee will be ((one)) two hundred twenty dollars.
