AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting the collective bargaining agreement and memorandum of understanding negotiated by and between King County and Service Employees International Union, Local 519, representing King County Civic Television employees; and establishing the effective date of said agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated between King County and Service Employees International Union, Local 519 (“SEIU”), representing King County Civic Television employees, and attached hereto, and the related memorandum of understanding between King County and SEIU, which was executed by SEIU on September 16, 2003, and is attached hereto, are hereby approved and adopted and by

this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement and the memorandum of understanding shall be effective from the date of enactment of this ordinance through and including December 31, 2005.
