WHEREAS, the Roads Operational Master Plan Phase II was subsequently transformed into the strategic plan for road services consistent with Ordinance 16202, the King County performance and accountability act, which required each county agency, department and office to develop a strategic plan to guide its ongoing and proposed activities for a five-year period, and

WHEREAS, a strategic plan for road services will provide guidance for a sustainable operational and financing model for the provision of road services, and

WHEREAS, the project advisory committee and work group have carried out the tasks envisioned in the Roads Operational Master Plan Phase II work plan to complete a strategic plan for road services, with the intent to define the mission, vision and focused direction for the provision of road services in King County for the next five years, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive has transmitted to the King County council with this motion the completed Strategic Plan for Road Services, developed collaboratively with staff from the department of transportation director's office, the road services division, the office of management and budget, the office of strategic planning and performance management, the facilities management division and the council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
