WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a

local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to

prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating

voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 19125 provides for the submission to the qualified electors of King County, at a special election to be held in conjunction with the general election on November 3, 2020, a proposition
