AN ORDINANCE relating to land use decisions; allowing for council review of the decisions of the hearings examiner relating to reasonable use exceptions; and adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 20.20.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>NEW SECTION. SECTION 1.</u> There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 20.20 a new section to read as follows:

Option for council review of examiner decisions regarding reasonable use exceptions.

- A. A decision by the king county hearings examiner on the appeal of a reasonable use exception may be reviewed by the king county council when a written request for council review of the decision is submitted to the clerk of the council within fourteen days of the date of the examiner decision.
- B. The council shall schedule a public hearing on the request for council review to a date no later than thirty days after the request is submitted.
- C. The council review shall be based upon the record established during the public hearing conducted by the examiner.
- D. The council action on the requested review shall be in the form of an ordinance either supporting, rejecting, or recommending reconsideration of, the examiner decision.
 - E. The council action may be appealed to superior court under the Land Use Petition Act.
 - F. There shall be no fee for the submittal of a request for review.

SECTION 2. Effective date and expiration date - submittal deadline. Section 1 of this ordinance is effective January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2006. All requests for council review authorized by this
