Title: AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special

election to be held in King County on August 16, 2011, of a proposition to provide regional health and human services to residents of King County by renewing and replacing authorization of the veterans and human services property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive six-year period at a first year rate of not more than \$0.05 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation, with subsequent maximum levy collections being increased by the greater of 1% or the percentage increase in the consumer price index as long as that amount does not exceed 3%, for the purpose of providing funding to enable the provision of health and human services such as affordable and supportive housing, mental health counseling, substance abuse prevention and treatment, employment assistance and other essential regional health and human services for residents of King County and establishing county citizen oversight boards to review and report on

expenditures of levy proceeds, contingent on voter approval of the levy.
