AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to execute an interlocal agreement with the cities of Renton and Tukwila regarding the transfer of ownership and the operation of city-owned traffic signals and related intelligent transportation system equipment by the King County road services division.

STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

- 1. The Trans-Valley corridor, defined as starting from SE 151st Street on Petrovitsky Road and follows along on SE 176th Street, Carr Road, SW 43rd Street, and onto S 180th Street where it ends at Southcenter Parkway, is a regional arterial that serves both unincorporated King County and city residents.
- 2. The county's intelligent transportation system ("ITS") project, which is identified in the road services division adopted six-year capital improvement plan as CIP #400400, will improve traffic flow by interconnecting and coordinating the signal system and providing transit signal priority along the corridor.
- 3. The operation of the city-owned traffic signals along the corridor by the King County road services division is vital to the implementation of the county's project.
- 4. Chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes the county and the city to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement such as Attachment A to this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, with the cities of Renton and Tukwila regarding the transfer of ownership and the operation of city-owned

traffic signals and related intelligent transportation system ("ITS") equipment by the King County road services division.
