where the human resources division evaluated the feasibility of creating and implementing a veterans'

internship program in King County, and

WHEREAS, the executive has transmitted to the council with this motion the required report, and

WHEREAS, the report provides:

1. A review and evaluation of existing county policies and practices impacting veterans, and makes

recommendations on the establishment of paid and unpaid veterans' internship programs;

2. An evaluation of how paid and unpaid veterans' internship programs would facilitate greater access and remove barriers to King County jobs for veterans;

3. A recommended implementation schedule;

4. An estimate of the costs of the program and identification of potential funding sources for paid

6. Proposed legislation necessary to implement an internship program;
