BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Sections 2 through 44 of this ordinance propose changes in the fees currently charged related to the department of permitting and environmental review, the department of transportation and the department of natural resources and parks.

B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.E.1.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10662, Section 49, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.02.080 are each hereby

amended to read as follows:

A. A fixed fee of two hundred ((thirty)) <u>fifty-three</u> dollars shall be charged for department staff time associated with all work done in conjunction with the intake, administration and release of financial guarantees for development permits.

B. A fee assessed at the department's current hourly rate shall be charged for department staff time associated with all work done in conjunction with the setting, monitoring, inspection and enforcement of financial guarantees for development permits.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 11141, Section 40, and K.C.C. 27.02.100 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

A general service fee assessed at the department's current hourly rate shall be charged for each of the following services:

A. Research performed outside the context of a pending application review;

B. Professional services to other governments under adopted interlocal agreement with the jurisdiction requesting the service;

C. Project management; ((and))

D. Public hearings; and

<u>E.</u> Any service not otherwise listed in ((the [this])) this title.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 11141, Section 41, and K.C.C. 27.02.110 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

((An applicant may elect to have a review, inspection, or permit approval completed by a department approved and hired contractor. For reviews, inspections, and permit approvals completed by a department approved contractor)) In addition to the fees required for review, processing or inspection by the department, the department is authorized to charge ((the)) an applicant ((the contract amount in addition to the required review, inspection, or permit fee)) for the cost charged by a department-hired contractor that reviews or processes an application or provides inspection or other services required in order to review a permit application.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 13332, Section 13, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.02.160 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The department may charge fees for clerical services unrelated to permits including, but not limited to, making copies, <u>scanning documents</u>, notarizing documents, gathering, preparing and publishing special request reports, and providing publications. The fees shall be at actual cost to the department and shall be collected at the time services are requested. The department shall publish a schedule of these fees.

B. ((The fee for a duplicate copy of a previously prepared certificate of elevation is two hundred twelve dollars.

C.)) The fee for annual certification of a tank removal contractor is one hundred ((seventy)) eighty-eight dollars.

 $((\underline{D}))$ <u>C</u>. The fee for a title elimination is sixty dollars.

 $((\underline{E}.))$ <u>D</u>. The fee for a zoning certification letter confirming an existing zoning designation or development rights is one hundred ((seventy)) <u>eighty-eight</u> dollars. The fee for zoning certification requiring historic research or review of other information is five hundred ((ten)) <u>sixty-four</u> dollars.

SECTION 6. Ordinance 16959, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.02.170 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Requests concerning residential addressing issues where no site visit is required shall be charged one hundred ((thirty-six)) fifty dollars per address. All other requests concerning addressing issues shall be charged at the department's current hourly rate.

SECTION 7. Ordinance 13332, Section 9, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.02.190 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The department's current hourly rate shall be assessed under this title at a rate of one hundred ((

seventy)) seventy-six dollars per hour.

B. The department of transportation's current hourly rate shall be assessed under this title at a rate of one hundred ((ten)) eleven dollars per hour.

C. The department of natural resources and parks's current hourly rate shall be assessed under this title at a rate of one hundred ten dollars per hour.

SECTION 8. Ordinance 13332, Section 3, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.06.005 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

The purpose of this chapter is to establish fees for preapplication submittal services((, permit administration and screening of applications submitted through the department's website. Preapplication fees shall compensate the department for preliminary review and evaluation of projects and for advising permit applicants before submittal of a formal application. Counter service fees shall compensate the department for land use and building counter services for application intake, calculation of fees, creation of manual and electronic files, preparing applications for routing to review stations, packaging final permits, issuance of final permits and providing fee and submittal information to applicants. Administrative fees shall be collected at the time administrative services are rendered)) and permit processing.
