STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. The King County Housing Authority desires to provide supplemental community policing services for residents at its southwest King County properties.
2. The county has the resources to provide these community policing services.
3. Participation in the agreement is to the benefit of the citizens of King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract agreement with King County Housing Authority, in substantially the form of Attachment

A to this ordinance, for community policing services at its southwest King County properties.
