BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The class action settlement agreement negotiated by and between King County and the plaintiffs in Dolan v. King County, Pierce County Superior Court Cause No. 06-2-04611-6, attached hereto and

by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved and adopted. Litigation counsel for King County is authorized to sign the settlement agreement on behalf of King County.

SECTION 2. Upon final approval of the class action settlement agreement by the
Pierce county superior court, the executive is directed to implement the terms of the settlement agreement.
